- \$60 for a wellness benefit
- \$200 for ambulance transportation
- \$125 for emergency room treatment
- \$1,200 for a fractured leg
- \$1,250 for internal injuries
- \$100 for two follow-up physician visits
- \$500 for five physical therapy sessions
